### Start me:

Friday Nov 17th All parcipants are expected to arrive between 1500 – 1900 hrs. If you are running late, please let Lt. Col Cryer know 940-390-9505.

### Sleeping Arrangements:

All parcipants are expected to bring own sleeping gear – tents included. Cadets of the same gender will be allowed to share tents. Tent sharing needs to be arranged prior to arrival. Siblings of opposite gender will not be allowed to share tents; they will need to provide their own individual tents.

### Meals:

Eat before you arrive; dinner will not be provided on Friday. Three meals will be provided Saturday and two meals will be provided on Sunday. Special diets or religious preferences are not guaranteed; those requiring such need to bring their own meals. All trainees may elect to bring your own food. Any meals brought by trainees will have to be prepared by themselves so please plan accordingly and bring what is needed to prepare your own food. Snacks will be provided but you might want to bring extra as well. Water, coffee, orange juice, and hot chocolate will be provided for all parcipants.

### Uniform and Gear:

Per the task guide, the prescribed ground team uniform is ABU or Blue BDU. It might get cold, please plan accordingly with appropriate layers and authorized cold weather gear. All ground team parcipants MUST have complete 24-hour packs, with addional items to replace and replenish used items throughout the weekend. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Those working on Ground Team 2 or Ground Team 1 MUST addionally have complete 72-hour packs.

### Friday Evening Preparatory Training:

First Aid training will be provided Friday evening starng at 19:30. All GTM3 familiarizaon and prep training will also be done Friday evening. ICUT evaluaons will be provided Friday evening, all training must be done in Axis prior to arrival.

## WHAT IS AIRMAN LEADERSHIP SCHOOL?

Airman Leadership School (ALS) is the first step in the Cadet Training and Education Program (CTEP). It is for all airmen, from airman basic through senior airman. ALS takes new cadets through everything that they will need before they go to encampment. It prepares them by having experienced cadet staff work with them on their uniforms, their boots, their drill movements, and many other aspects of cadet life.

# CADET ENCAMPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CEAP)

**CTEP APPLICATIONS OPEN NOVEMBER 1ST!**

APPLICATIONS CLOSE THE SUNDAY AFTER THANKSGIVING.

## WHAT ASSISTANCE IS AVAILABLE

CADETS AND THEIR FAMILIES MAY APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE WITH ENCAMPMENT FEES, OR BOTH UNIFORMS AND ENCAMPMENT FEES.

TUITION. ENCAMPMENT FEE ASSISTANCE WILL COVER 100% OF THE TUITION FEES AND WILL BE PAID DIRECTLY TO THE WING (STATE) SELECTED IN THE APPLICATION.

UNIFORMS. UNIFORM ASSISTANCE IS PROVIDED IN THE FORM OF VOUCHERS THAT MAY BE USED FOR SPECIFIC UNIFORM ITEMS AT VANGUARD. THE VOUCHER MAY BE FOR \$75 OR \$125, DEPENDING ON THE FINANCIAL PRIORITY LEVEL OF THE CADET.
